A Woodland Dictionary



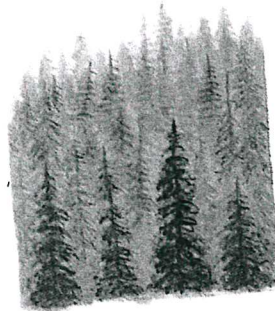
acorn

evergreen trees that bear cones



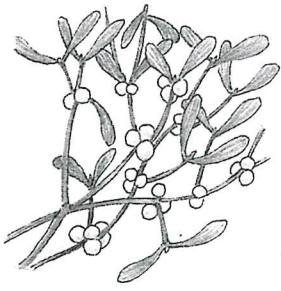
hawthorn

trees that lose their leaves each year



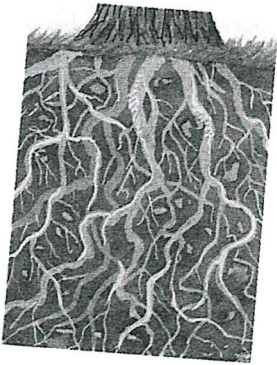
laurel
