Things you need to know about the TV Licence

You will need a TV Licence if you:

- watch or record TV programmes live on any channel; or
- download or watch any BBC programmes on iPlayer – live, catch up or on demand.

You can watch TV in lots of different ways:



On a TV set



On a computer or laptop



On a mobile phone or a tablet (like an iPad or Samsung Galaxy)



Using a digital box that works with your TV (like Sky or Virgin)



Using a Blu-ray, DVD or video recorder



With a games console (like a PlayStation or Xbox)

A TV Licence costs **£154.50**



If you're aged 75 or older you could get a free TV Licence.



If you're blind you could get a half-price TV Licence.



If you live in a care home you could pay less for a TV Licence.

Getting a TV Licence

There are different ways to buy a TV Licence.



You can use your credit or debit card.



You can pay at any PayPoint using a debit card or cash.



You can set up a direct debit.



You can send us a cheque in the post.
