




### Sensory

### **Mystery Bag**



### You will need:

- Pillow Case/ Cloth Bag
- Favourite Objects belonging to your child such as a picture of their favourite food, a musical instrument, a toy and so on. You will need about 5 items

### What to do:

- Place all the objects in the bag.
- Allow your child to pull out the objects from their bag and allow them to feel the item.
- Investigate all 5 items in the bag, taking pictures of them with their favourite item.

### **Feeling Bins**



### You will need:

- Plastic eggs or cooled boiled eggs
- Black permanent pens
- Rice Kripsies
- Egg cartons or plastic lids to stand eggs on

### What to do:

- Draw different feelings faces on each of the eggs happy, sad, cross, worried, excited and so on.
- Cut up the egg cartons into individual egg pieces.
- Place the rice krispies into a box and put the eggs into the rice krispies.
- Find the eggs and talk about the faces and the feelings.

### Art

### You Are My Sunshine



#### You will need:

- Paper plates
- Yellow paint different colours of yellow
- Black pen

### What to do:

- Paint a small yellow circle in the middle of the plate
- Using different colours of yellow, paint your child's hand and do prints around the outside edge of the plate, with the bottom of their palm facing into the middle.
- Once dry, use a black pen to draw on the face, write the slogan across the top and write your child's name on the bottom and the date.

# Cookery

#### **Pancake Faces**



#### You will need:

- Giant pancakes
- Fruit or other yummy toppings

#### What to do:

Cut up fruit into pieces, place on the table and allow your child to decorate their pancake as they please.

Or you could decorate the pancake for your child and then talk about the different parts of the face such as ears, hair, eyes, nose and so on.

# Mark-Making Just for Fun

### **Chalk Painting**

Practice your writing skills outside using chalks on the ground – the rain will wash it away.

Use a paintbrush and a tub of water to paint over your chalk drawings – this will give the chalk a vibrant colour.



#### **Painting The Fence**

You can pretend to help paint the fence at home using water and a big paintbrush. This is lots of fun and helps you to build up your writing muscles in your hands.



Lockdown Art

Create a piece of art, with the help of your family to remember when you all stayed together in 2020

Ask each person in the house to trace their hand on a piece of paper and cut it out. Then stick each hand together on a blank page and write an inspirational phrase about staying at home, such as:

When the world stayed apart, we stayed together.

**Straw race** – use drinking straws and small light objects to have race, blowing the objects along a table. The winner is the person who gets their object across the finish line first.








Scavenger hunt
