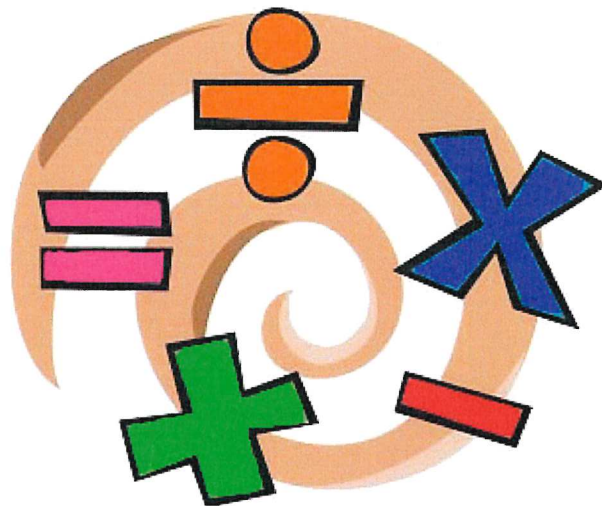

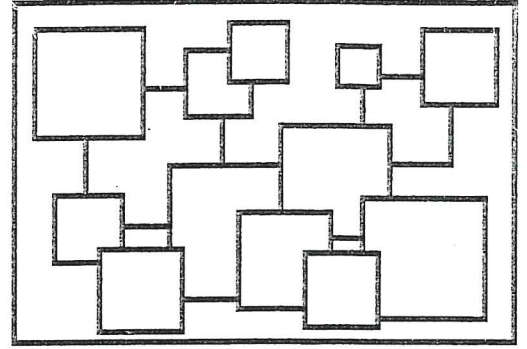

*He wasn't there?*

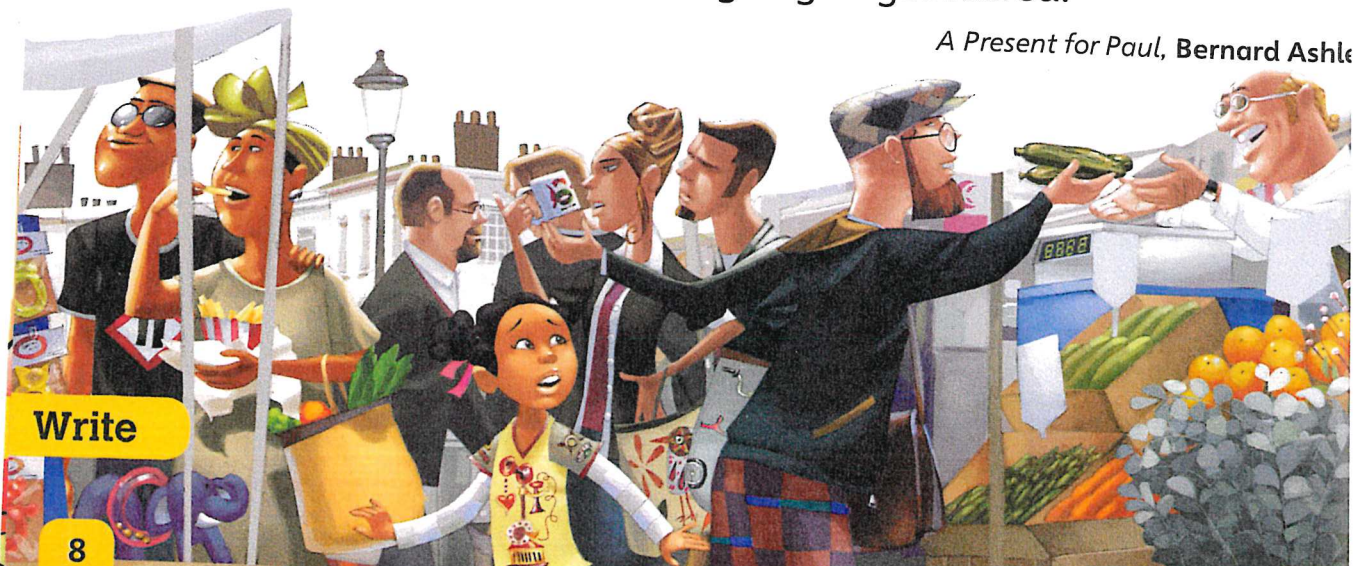
Where was he?
