- If you have magnetic letters play with those, make words starting with the letter
- Play I-spy
- Match upper and lower case letters E-e

Number of the week – 3

- Write the number
- Count items of that number
- Make collections of the number
- Find the number around the house
- Make the number out of play doh
- Talk about the number before and the number after
- Add one more on to the number, take one away from the number
- Write the number as a word
