NUMERACY IDEAS -

Use household items to create a 'shop':

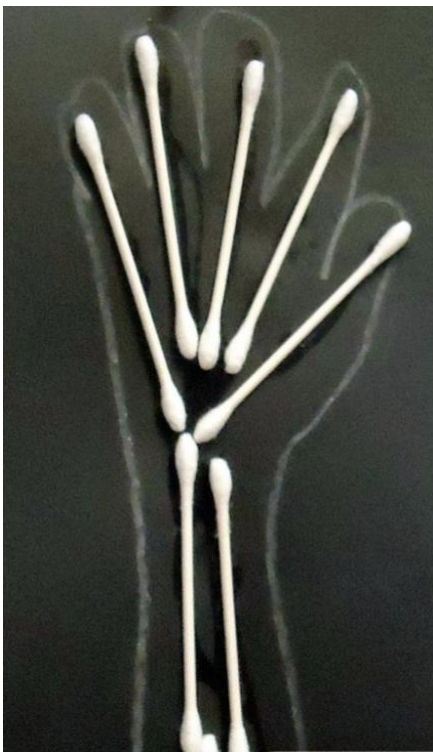
